# **Sencorex Flow**

### Sencorex Flow is a key component in weed control programmes:

## **Application Rate**


The maximum individual application rate of Sencorex Flow is 1.15 I/ha applied pre-emergence for earlies (except on light and very light soils) and maincrop potatoes (all soil types).

# Please read product label and latest variety update information carefully when planning herbicide programmes.

A further 'top-up' application of 0.55 I/ha may be applied early post-emergence to named varieties.

If using Sencorex Flow in place of a WDG formulation, apply at the equivalent field rate to achieve similar or better levels of control, e.g. 0.75 I/ha Sencorex Flow replaces 0.75 kg/ha metribuzin 70% WDG.

Trials have confirmed superior control from Sencorex Flow (see chart).
