
March is a great month to make preparations for producing quality grass for the whole season, whether it be spraying off old pasture ready for reseeding or making preparations for early grass growth.

Boost early grass growth – just when it's needed

SmartGrass is a sprayable formulation of gibberellic acid (GA3), a natural plant growth hormone, and is specifically designed for enhanced production of grass dry matter in the cool conditions of early spring. SmartGrass is ideal for rotational grazing and will boost grass growth after early grazing rounds. Increase in grass Dry Matter can be 50% more than untreated, 21 days after application. Many trials have shown increased grass production of over 0.5t DM/ha, 3 weeks after application.





Pastures grow more dry matter – FAST. Spray in March to fill the "Hungry Gap"

Ryegrass leaves die back after 28 days so – Use it or lose it

How do I use SmartGrass?

- Apply fertiliser as normal in early spring.
- Graze paddocks to 3 -5cm (1500 kgDM/ha)
- Grass must have started to grow in March/April
- Apply SmartGrass within 0 – 5 days of stock removal with a conventional boom sprayer.
- Rate = 20g/ha in 200 litres water/ha
- Graze again 21


