

Sycamore Seedling Control in Horse Pasture



The prolonged frosts in early 2023 broke the dormancy of sycamore seeds causing mass germination, and a flush of sycamore seedlings over the last few weeks, particularly around the edges of fields and paddocks.

Sycamore seedlings can be **acutely toxic to horses** if ingested whilst grazing grass and may even be fatal.

Thrust herbicide is highly effective at controlling sycamore seedlings:



Untreated



4 days after treatment



BEST USE GUIDELINES

Remove horses from pasture to be treated

Apply 3.5 litres/ha Thrust via boom sprayer

Or spot treat by knapsack (90 ml in 10 litres water)

Target weeds at seedling stage up to 4 true leaves

Keep horses and livestock out of treated area for a minimum of 2 weeks or longer if needed for the sycamore or any other injurious weeds to have completely disappeared.

Thrust is a professional product and should only be applied by persons with appropriate spraying certification.
